### **Thy Kingdom Come Begins - 14th May:**

Thy Kingdom Come (TKC) is a global, ecumenical, prayer movement that invites Christians to pray for more people to come to know Jesus. It began in 2016 as an invitation from the Archbishops of Canterbury and York to the Church of England but has now grown into an international call to prayer. TKC starts on Ascension (14th May) and runs through to Pentecost (24<sup>th</sup> May). Resources will be distributed to help you pray during TKC. We will also be organising 24 hours of continuous prayer on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> May, you are invited to sign up (sheet at the back of church) for a prayer slot during this time. TKC will come to an end with a celebratory Pentecost Breakfast at 8.30am on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> May.
