Church Services – UPDATED

Pre-booking is no longer required, but we will continue to display the NHS QR code on the South Door, as well as providing a manual sign up sheet for those who would like to be notified of contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid.

Congregational singing will be permitted at the 10am Service.

Everyone will be encouraged to wear a mask when they enter and leave, move to receive communion, or use the facilities.

At the 8am Service you will be able to remove your mask once seated.

At the 10am Service the building will be sectioned into the following two separate seating zones and you are free to choose according to your preference:

- **Zone 1** – will be at the front of the building; there will be no special distancing; in this area you will be able to remove your mask once seated, talk with others and sing.
- **Zone 2** – will be at the back of the building; spaces will be 1 metre socially distanced; in this area we ask that you continue wearing masks but you can sing.

As we navigate these changes, we hope to find a way forward that suits as many as possible. To that end, we shall continue to review the arrangements regularly. If you have any feedback or questions, please do send an email or speak with one of the Churchwardens or James.
