## Send Prison Lunch in Church:

Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> August at 12 noon in aid of Send Prison Chaplain's Discretionary Fund. Rev Lesley Mason is the senior Chaplain at Send who house 300 women inmates. When they are released, each woman receives £76. Some of them have families nearby, but many are on their own and the only people they know are the ones that landed them in prison! The instance of re-offending is high and Lesley is trying to break this cycle. See the poster and leaflet at the back of Church for more information.

## Godalming Foodbank:

We will be commencing a monthly collection of essential items for the Foodbank, starting on Sunday 3rd July. For the week before, there will be a box at the back of Church for donations. Urgently needed: school holiday lunch parcels to include snacks (crisps etc.), children's drinks, fruit shoots and individually wrapped biscuits/cakes.
